The University of Electronic Science and Technology of China (UESTC) is a high quality university located in the beautiful city of Chengdu, south-western China's science and technology hub and financial centre. Its School of Medicine was jointly established in 2013 with Sichuan Provincial People's Hospital, one of China's best hospitals. The school has 192 faculties, including two professors selected for the Thousand Talents Plan and one awardee of the National Science Fund for Distinguished Young Scholars. It has two honorary professors, including a Nobel Laureate in Physiology or Medicine, and is currently hosting a visiting professor.

POSITIONS AVAILABLE

The School of Medicine, UESTC, has faculty positions at full, associate or assistant professor levels, available immediately. Positions are all in biomedical fields, including, but not limited to, microbiology, immunology, genetics, biochemistry, molecular biology, anatomy, physiology, pathology and pharmacology.

QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should have a doctoral degree (PhD or MD) and no less than three years' research and/or work experience abroad, and be under the age 40. They should be eligible for the national Thousand Young Talents Program or have the potential to become leading figures in their field. Once accepted, candidates are expected to work full-time in China. Applicants with exceptional academic achievements may be exempted from the above requirements.

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

UESTC offers a generous employment package, including salaries, relocation allowances and start-up funds. Qualified candidates may also obtain city or provincial talent funds and those selected for the Thousand Young Talents Program will be appointed as professors and PhD supervisors. Additional support may be negotiated.

RECRUITMENT PROCESS

1. Applicants submit relevant materials, including a curriculum vitae, representative academic papers and recommendation letters.
2. The school's Selection Board interviews qualified applicants.
3. UESTC's Selection Board interviews nominated candidates.
4. UESTC signs employment agreements with new employees.
